Join Mrs. McGehee and Mrs. King for an Atlanta Adventure of a lifetime. Our week long Atlanta adventure includes educationally focused visits to Zoo Atlanta, World of Coca-Cola, Georgia Aquarium, High Museum of Art, CNN Studios, and Atlanta Botanical Gardens.

Each day will start at 9AM and end at 4PM at the Dunwoody Marta Station. Students will need to bring a small backpack, a sack lunch, a small notepad, pencil, and a refillable water bottle. Students have the option of bringing money to purchase lunch on days 2, 3, and 5.

#### Day 1

#### Georgia Dome Tour and Georgia Aquarium

The campers will start the day with a tour of The Georgia Dome, the largest cable-supported domed stadium in the world. The guided tour includes stops at the observatory deck, suites, press box, locker rooms, and field. Next, we will plunge into a one-of-a-kind experience with the world's largest collection of aquatic animals and over 8 million gallons of water. The Georgia Aquarium's five unique galleries house hundreds of species including whale sharks, beluga whales, otters and many more. Following our Aquarium visit, instructors and campers will gather in Centennial Olympic Park for physical activities.

#### Day 2

### The State Capitol, The King Center, and The Varsity

The campers will visit the working center of Georgia's state government - The Georgia State Capitol. The tour will give the campers a first hand view of the most important government building in the state, as well as an overview of Georgia's history. Then, we will take a look back to the days of the Civil Rights Movement at The King Center, established in 1968 by Coretta Scott King. Here, we will observe the official, living memorial dedicated to the advancement of the legacy of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Next, we will ride the Marta train to the Varsity for an authentic Atlanta lunch. After lunch we will work out some energy in Centennial Olympic Park with some interactive games.

#### Day 3

#### CNN Tour and Coca-Cola® Museum

In the morning, we will journey into the heart of CNN Worldwide and get an up-close look at global news in the making. Inside CNN Studio Tour is a 55-minute guided walking tour offering guests exclusive, behindthe scenes views of Atlanta's CNN studios and an exciting glimpse of news gathering and broadcasting in action from the world headquarters of CNN. We will eat lunch in the CNN Center. The campers can bring money to buy lunch or enjoy a lunch from home. On our way to the World of Coca-Cola®, we will stop in Centennial Olympic Park and burn some calories following lunch. In the afternoon, the campers will visit the World of Coca-Cola®, where everyone will be enlightened and entertained by an array of activities. From a thrilling 4D theater, to a walk through a fullyfunctioning bottling line, the campers will experience something new and inviting around every corner. We will end our day by taking our taste buds on a tantalizing tour of over 60 different Coca-Cola products from around the world.



#### Day 4

#### The Botanical Gardens, Federal Reserve Bank of Atlanta and The High Museum of Art

In the morning, we will visit the Atlanta Botanical Gardens where there is always something blooming in the heart of Midtown Atlanta. We will explore Atlanta Botanical Garden's 30 acres of breathtaking gardens and conservatories, including the country's largest orchid house and celebrated interactive children's garden. The students will extend their understanding of plant classification and enrich their knowledge of native Georgia plant life. Instructors and campers will gather in Piedmont Park for lunch. After lunch we will walk to the Federal Reserve Bank of Atlanta. We will spend about an hour at the Visitors Center and Monetary Museum that features a display on the history of money; interactive, multimedia exhibits explaining the Federal Reserve's role in the economy, and a view of the bank's automated vault and cash processing areas. Next, we will take a short walk to the High Museum of Art, the Southeast's largest art museum distinguished by the renowned architecture of Richard Meier and Renzo Piano. The High Museum's light-filled galleries showcase an inspiring permanent collection and masterful exhibitions from around the world.

#### Day 5

#### Zoo Atlanta

The campers will stand eye-to-eye with nearly 1,000 of the world's most amazing animals at one of Georgia's most beloved destinations. Zoo Atlanta highlights include giant pandas and nationally renowned collections of great apes. Campers can enjoy the Zoo train, carousel, petting zoo and playgrounds along with zookeeper talks and interactive wildlife shows!
