


RIDE OPTIONS

Family Route on the Jim Benson Bike Trail: 8 Miles

This police-supported route is the same we took last year and follows the green painted markers.

No TRAINING WHEELS, please.



A great route for those younger riders who are just becoming comfortable riding, as well as those who would just like to "give it a try" and sample a short route. Police-supported.



This unescorted route is for experienced bike riders who are comfortable riding on the road and are able to ride at an average pace on flats of 17+ mph. There will be "A" (20+ MPH) and "B" paced groups riding together.

+ Rest Stop at mile 19 at Roswell River Park on Riverside Drive. 29 mile option turnaround here.


