



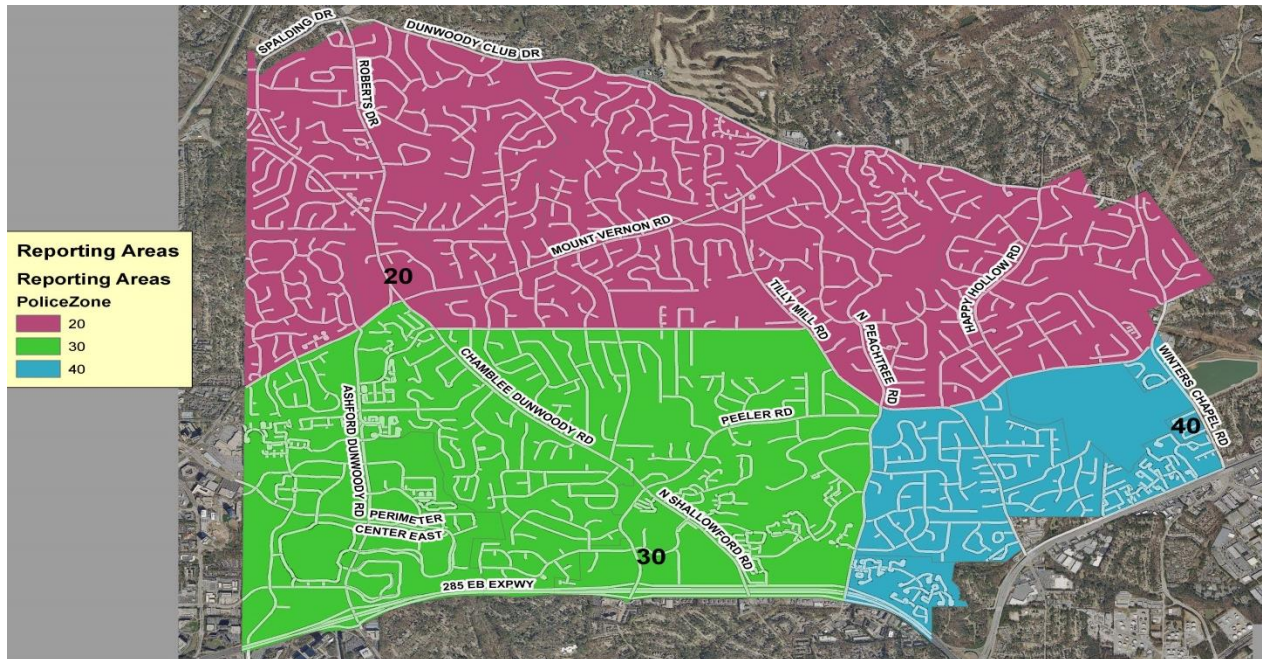
## Neighborhood Watch Weekly Report 5/11-5/17
