**DID YOU KNOW???**

- There are # Arrests of drug/alcohol issues under the age of 19 in OUR City of Dunwoody?
- An adolescent takes fewer than 15 months of drug use to form a lifetime addictive personality, permanently altering their brain chemistry vs. a 30 year old adult takes 8-10 years to reach the chronic stages of addiction.
- Kids who learn about the risks of alcohol and other drugs from their parents are up to 50% less likely to use.
- Middle School children are at the greatest risk for first time drug use?
- Kids reduce drug use by 65% if Middle School prevention programs are in place.
